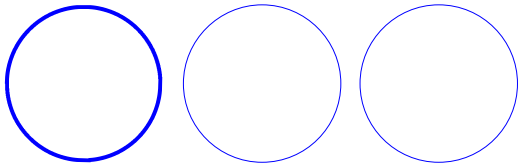

Staff Members

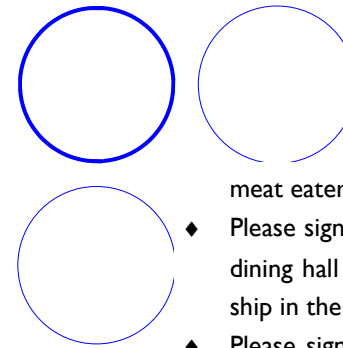
The Volunteer Manager is available 24 hours a day by phone and in the office at the front of the camp during business hours. The Night Manager is available from 5pm-12am Sunday through Friday night. Please see either of these staff members for t-shirts, wristbands, directions and questions.

Local Activities

The Gulf Coast has some great parks, attractions and wildlife areas including Gulf Islands National Seashore and the Mississippi Sand Hill Crane National Wildlife Refuge. Popular activities include swimming in the Gulf (be careful of debris from the storm), jogging in the local community, walking the Biloxi bridge at sunset and visiting local stores and restaurants. Ocean Springs is known for it's artistic influence and great art galleries and pottery. For suggestions on activities or restaurants please look through the resources at the volunteer resource center located next to the Volunteer Manager's office or see the Volunteer Manager in the office at the front of the building..

Camp Rules & Procedures

- ◆ Shirt, shoes, pants, nametags and wristbands must be worn at all times in camp.
- ◆ We have a no tolerance policy for alcohol, drugs, intoxication, violence, theft or weapons
- ◆ Quiet time is from 10pm-6am. There is no talking during this time. Quiet activities are okay in the lounge and dining hall until 11pm.
- ◆ Headphones must be used with audio, video and computer devices.
- ◆ No food, drink or candy in the lounge.
- ◆ Please be considerate of others waiting to use the computers and limit time.
- ◆ No food, drink or candy in the dorms with the exception of water.
- ◆ Not allowed in opposite sex's dorms.
- ◆ Please use headphones for audio, video and computer devices.
- ◆ Please do not keep cash or valuables in the dorm room. Carry them with you, secure them in a vehicle or get a lock from the Volunteer Manager to use a locker.
- ◆ Please clean up after yourself in the dining hall, dorms, lounge and restrooms.
- ◆ Adult supervision of 1 adult per 4 minors is required for anyone under the age of 18 outside their dorm at 10pm.
- ◆ Please sign up for dinner on the Daily Meal Sign up board in the dining hall each day before you leave for the construction site. Please note the number of vegetarians and



meat eaters in your group.

- ◆ Please sign up on the Prayer Board in the dining hall if you would like to lead worship in the morning or evening.
- ◆ Please sign and date food left in the volunteer refrigerator.
- ◆ No open toed shoes are allowed if you are working in the kitchen or warehouse.
- ◆ The kitchen and pantry are off limits to volunteers except for volunteers assigned to the kitchen or helping with clean up.
- ◆ No guests may stay here without reservations.
- ◆ Breakfast is served at 7am and dinner at 6pm. Please make bag lunches at 6:30am to take with you to site .
- ◆ Please no smoking in front of the building
- ◆ Please do not prop the door open by the smoker's patio. The smoke trails inside.
- ◆ All murals must be approved by the Volunteer Manager before your group begins
- ◆ Please report all incidents, on site or at camp, to the Volunteer Manager.

**The exterior doors lock at 4pm until the following morning. Please see the volunteer manager or the night manager for the code to the front door.
