# FACING RACISM TASK FORCE

The First Presbyterian Church at Caldwell's Facing Racism Task Force invites you to a fall/winter book study of a new book, co-authored by West Orange, NJ resident, Kerry Connelly. Published in 2022, Wait – Is This Racist? A Guide to Becoming an Anti-Racist Church has already gotten positive reviews. Pastor and author Robert W. Lee described the book as this: "...You have before you a guidebook, a survival guide, a deconstruction chisel, and a faithful interpretation of the reign of God that is at hand. This book made me think critically about my own blind spots while also acknowledging the potential areas of growth that could happen in my personal and professional life. ... You would be wise to sit with this book—it will change you." Connelly's co-authors of the book are Bryana Clover and Josh Riddick.

The Facing Racism Task Force will be able to provide the book to you free of charge. This study will meet via Zoom for five Thursdays on the following dates: **Oct. 27**, **Nov. 17**, **Dec. 8**, **Jan. 12 & Jan. 26**. Meeting times will be from 7:30 pm – 8:45 pm.
