<u>OUR CHRISTIAN CALL TO GRATITUDE,</u> GENEROSITY AND STEWARDSHIP

We invite you to read this passage from scripture and to reflect upon God's call to each of us to be grateful and generous stewards.

Luke 13:18-21 (Parable of the mustard seed and yeast)
Big and small gifts are appreciated and can be used by God.
There is hardly a more beautiful way to speak about the hidden promises of even the smallest gift than the image of the mustard seed, so tiny yet holding so much possibility. Or for those who are bakers, the yeast provides a similar illustration. We are given so many gifts from God, and we are called to give back. So we share our gifts so that God can use them and grow them just like the mustard seed becomes a tree big enough for birds and the yeast grows big enough to make the bread and provide substance for us.

WHY IS IT IMPORTANT TO MAKE A PLEDGE COMMITMENT FOR 2023?
