The First Presbyterian Church at Caldwell and Congregation Agudath Israel are teaming up once again this year to invite you to participate in a Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Day of Service Project benefitting the 7th Street Bistro of Memorial West United Presbyterian Church in Newark, New Jersey. This soup kitchen helps to address some of the food insecurity needs of families who live in the West Ward of Newark. We will be collecting requested items to help restock the food pantry of 7th Street Bistro of Memorial West United Presbyterian Church.

Members of Congregation Agudath Israel and First Presbyterian Church will be stationed outside of First Presbyterian Church at Caldwell (326 Bloomfield Ave, Caldwell, NJ) on the circle/staff parking lot to receive drive-by donations: Date: Sunday 1-15-23 Time: 12:00 pm – 2:00 pm

Members of both congregations will also be stationed in the parking lot of Jack's Foodtown (Caldwell) to collect donations. Date: Monday (Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Day) 1-16-23 Time: 12:00 pm – 4:00 pm

Requested items

- Vegetable soup, tomato soup, cream of chicken or cream of mushroom soups
- Crackers
- Canned tuna fish or pink salmon, canned chicken
- Peanut butter, grape or strawberry jelly/jam
- Assorted canned fruit (pears, pineapple, peaches)
- Apple sauce (or mixed fruit)
- Canned vegetables: green beans, greens, peas and carrots, corn, spinach, mixed vegetables, sweet potatoes

SIGN UP TO HOST COFFEE HOUR


