# PER CAPITA APPORTIONMENT

Per Capita Apportionment is the amount of money paid to the presbytery, synod and General Assembly by every Presbyterian Church to share in the cost of coordinating and evaluating mission. Per Capita is calculated on church membership, based on the assigned amount for 2023 of \$40.00 per active member. Our congregation's per capita obligation for 2023 is approximately \$19,000.00. In order that this payment does not have to be drawn from operating funds, we ask that all current members submit their per capita contribution (including payments on behalf of confirmed youth). *Please note that per capita does not apply to children who are not yet confirmed*.

Payment may be made by using the "per capita" offering envelope provided, if you requested envelopes, or by whatever method you currently make your financial gifts to our church. If paying by check, please put "per capita" in the memo line of your check.
