SESSION HIGHLIGHTS JUNE 20, 2023

The Session met June 20, 2023. The first 90 minutes was spent on passing motions and receiving reports. The last 60 minutes was spent in a team building discussion led by three of the elders. Action items and report information included:

* Further discussion on the table group reports from April 29. Session members had been asked in May to take the 6 topics and pick the 2 with the highest priority. The top 2 were strategic planning for growth and congregational morale. Elders were to think about what information needed to be gathered yet and will be writing that out and sharing with all.

* Approval was given to purchasing a new, adjustable organ bench.

* Children and Youth Ministry reported that Sunday school started its summer break June 18 and will resume September 10.

* There was an information update on preparing an active shooter safety policy for the church as now required by New Jersey laws. The team working on this will meet June 2 to continue working on it.

* Personnel Committee reported the successful hiring of Valerie Shondel as Music Director and Celesta Silveira as office assistant.

* Communications Committee reported on the ongoing progress on updating the church Facebook page. It is progressing albeit more slowly than was hoped for.

* Stewardship Committee will be meeting in July to begin planning the stewardship campaign for 2024 pledges.

* Mission Committee reported on plans for a Mission Fair and Volunteer sign-up on September 24. It also reported that money from the Pleasantdale funds designated for mission work in the West Orange area will be used in part to support Christine's Kitchen feeding programs. Additional ways to serve that community are being explored.

* Reports were received from our Nursery School board and from the Prospect Hill Cemetery committee. The Nursery School will be able to increase its contribution back to the church \$15,000.

* The newest Adult Education newsletter was shared with Session and will be available through links in upcoming First Press newsletters.

* There will be no stated business meeting in July unless there is pressing business and a need for a vote by the Session. The third Tuesday in July may be used to continue the team-building sharing.


