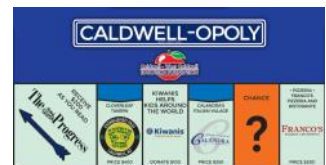
PER CAPITA APPORTIONMENT

Per Capita Apportionment is the amount of money paid to the presbytery, synod and General Assembly by every Presbyterian Church to share in the cost of coordinating and evaluating mission. Per Capita is calculated on church membership, based on the assigned amount for 2022 of \$40.00 per active member (active members include confirmed youth, as well as adults). This February, the “Per Capita Special Offering” will be received and you are invited and encouraged to participate by contributing the amount of \$40.00 for each active member in your family.
