HELP US LAY A FOUNDATION FOR OUR FUTURE

Members are invited to join in laying a foundation for future planning, and starting to meet the concern about planning raised at our Annual Congregational meeting. We'll come together on April 29, 9 am – Noon. Using information from the CAT report, we will break into groups to look at 9 priority areas of church life

1. Developing a strategy and making changes to bring in new families
2. Hospitality and welcoming people
3. Church Morale
4. Conflict Management
5. Governance and decision-making processes
6. Spiritual Vitality
7. Readiness for Ministry - Assessing people's gifts and helping them use their gifts
8. Educational Engagement – Christian education a life-long process
9. Worship and Music

Each group will take their assigned area.. The group will answer the questions below for their area : What additional information do we need? How might we get that information? What resources are needed/helpful? What are Strengths currently in place to apply to this concern? What are Weaknesses we currently face? What Opportunities are available to us? What Threats/Challenges are there? What do we need to proceed with addressing this? The end result will have developed 9 foundational plans for taking the next steps in strategic planning that can include the next called pastor.
