- 9. Worship and Music

Each group will take their assigned area. The group will answer the questions below for their area: What additional information do we need? How might we get that information? What resources are needed/helpful? What are Strengths currently in place to apply to this concern? What are Weaknesses we currently face? What Opportunities are available to us? What Threats/Challenges are there? What do we need to proceed with addressing this? The end result will have developed 9 foundational plans for taking the next steps in strategic planning that can include the next called pastor.
