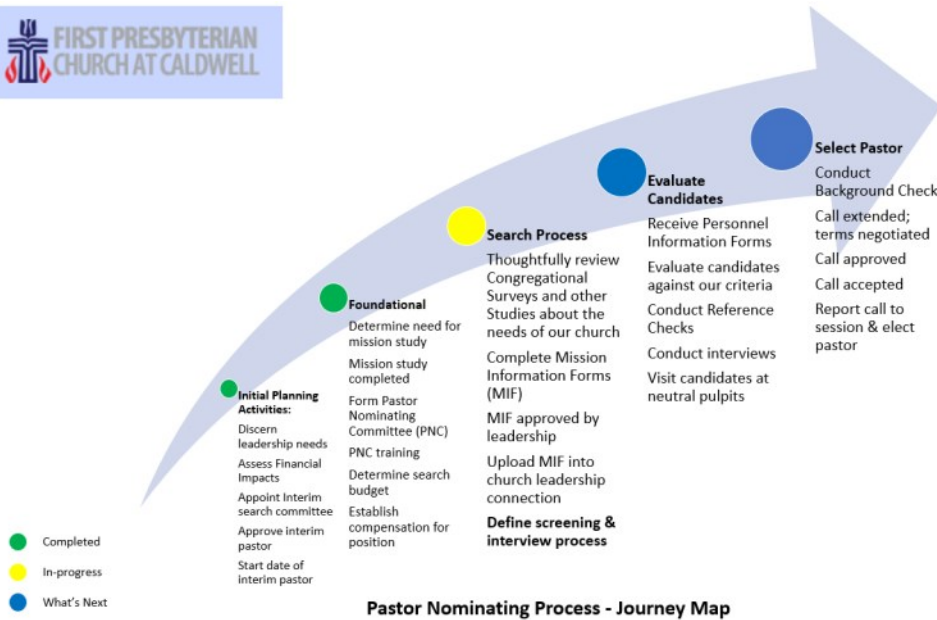
SIGN UP TO HOST OR BAKE FOR COFFEE HOUR/LEMONADE ON THE LAWN
