Presbytery has assessed the 2026 Per Capita at \$37.00 per member.

Presbytery per capita is crucial in Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) (PC(USA)) for funding shared governance and mission, acting as the "glue" that connects congregations to their regional presbytery, synod, and national church (PC(USA)) by equitably sharing administrative costs, supporting leadership training, ministerial development (like ordination exams), and enabling collective mission beyond local churches, reinforcing unity and shared purpose as a "body of Christ".

It's a financial commitment demonstrating mutual support and enabling the wider church's work.
